One newcomer for this year is the new Royal Oak favorite **Pastaio**. Known for its renowned fresh handmade pasta and brick oven pizza, the Royal Oak location opened in November of last year. Another newcomer to this year's festival lineup is **Estia Greek Street Food**. With locations in Warren and Grosse Pointe, it offers healthy, Greek-inspired food that is easy to eat and full of delicious, simple ingredients.

Several notable favorites are returning to the festival including the **Soaring Eagle Cuisine Machine.** Attendees will have the chance to indulge in the captivating and delectable fine dining experiences of Soaring Eagle Casino & Resort on wheels. Additionally, **ImaginAte**, a Royal Oak restaurant run by the talented Omar Mitchell, will be back and delighting visitors with an exceptional array of locally sourced and freshly made options. Another returning favorite is the **Detroit Hot Sandwich Co.**, formerly known as Delray Barbeque, which will be treating patrons to

its mouthwatering hot deli sandwiches, including pulled pork, its version of a hot Cuban sandwich and its famous mac & cheese.

## **Baker College Culinary Students Shine**

Baker College, renowned for its top-notch culinary arts program, has teamed up with two local businesses and a nonprofit organization to present an extraordinary showcase at the festival. Three exceptionally talented culinary students from the college have collaborated with local restaurateurs to create exclusive menu items for this special occasion. Notably, a portion of the proceeds generated from the sale of these unique dishes will be generously donated to Open Hands Pantry, a community-based nonprofit food pantry that serves those in need. The exciting newly crafted recipes include:

**Honey Chipotle Glazed Chicken** made by Steven Stempnik working alongside and in the kitchen of **ImaginATE** restaurant. This summertime savory special will feature marinated chicken legs and a Honey Chipotle glaze all placed atop a bed of delicious seasonal zucchini, squash, carrots, peppers and onion that ImaginATE will be offering on its festival menu.

**Chewy Lemon Brownies** created by Maya Van Buskirk with guidance from **Give Thanks Bakery**. This delectable treat features a soft lemon brownie base with a refreshing honey, lemon and cream cheese glaze with a fresh lemon zest twist that will be on the restaurant's festival menu.

For those thirsty for something new, Baker College culinary student Mikal Jones developed a **Smoke Cherry Bourbon Blast** cocktail made with bourbon, honey, orange and lemon juice, finished off with a Cajun spice rim and garnished with a cherry and orange slice. This specialty cocktail will be available at the **Bar on 6th Street** next to the Baker College Country Americana Stage.
